- The winner receives a full song development from scratch with Grammy nominee Geoff Byrd, be invited to VIP parties, outings and events.
- Winner will also receive bonus treatment, be pitched to radio & television and be introduced to talent agents.
- All of the top 11 finalists go on tour throughout the Portland metro area with over 8 performances already on calendar and more to come.
- A TV show is being made from it that will start airing in September.
